Vendors - Rules

Craft Vendors

Craft vendors must sell recognized First Nation Handmade Crafts – no flea market items will be tolerated (Vender will be asked to leave the grounds).

The rates for a 10'X12' space are reserved for the weekend as a whole, not daily and are **nonrefundable**. Parking is available at the school parking lot. Vendors who sell goods from vans or trucks are permitted to park on the grounds, so long as they do not occupy more than their allotted 10' by 12' space.

Items forbidden to be sold: Trinkets and imported items, Eagle feathers, Flea Market Items, Ceremonial items & Arial toys (Slingshots, bows and arrows ect.)

Food Vendors

The rates for a 10'x 12' space are reserved for the weekend as a whole, not daily and are **nonrefundable**. Food vendors are advised to follow sanitation practices. The KZA Pow Wow committee assumes no responsibility for any problems arising from non-compliance of these practices. Electricity is used for sound only. If you have a reasonably quiet generator, it would be appreciated.

1. Keep area clean at all times. Designated area must be cleaned and free of sugar, salt, pepper packages, and napkins at all times. This will help keep the Pow wow grounds clean.
2. Provide your own fire extinguisher.
3. Ensure propane tanks conform with safety regulations and should not be used near flammable objects (e.g. tarps)
4. The vendor is responsible for standard food handling procedures. It is mandatory for the vendors to use a hair net and gloves while handling food.

ALL booth inscription fees are for the full weekend and NON REFUNDABLE.

No electricity or power outlets are provided vendors are responsible for providing their own generator.
